One: We confess to you, O God, all our past unfaithfulness: the pride, hypocrisy, and impatience in our lives,

- One: Our self-indulgent appetites and ways and our exploitation of other people,

- One: Our anger at our own frustration and our envy of those more fortunate than ourselves,

All: we confess to you, O God.

- One: Our intemperate love of worldly goods and comforts, and our dishonesty in daily life and work,
- All: we confess to you, O God.
- One: Our negligence in prayer and worship, and our failure to commend the faith that is in us,
- All: we confess to you, O God.

- One: Accept our repentance, O God, for the wrongs we have done. For our neglect of human need and suffering and our indifference to injustice and cruelty,
- All: accept our repentance, O God.
- One: For all false judgments, for uncharitable thoughts toward our neighbors, and for our prejudice and contempt toward those who differ from us,

All: accept our repentance, O God.

- One: For our waste and pollution of your creation and our lack of concern for those who come after us,
- All: accept our repentance, O God.

One: Restore us, O God,

All: and let your anger depart from us.

One: Favorably hear us, O God,

All: for your mercy is great. Amen.
